I am requesting funding for the Port of Alaska Modernization Program (PAMP) Electric Substation project in Fiscal Year 2026. The entity to receive funding for this project is the Don Young Port of Alaska (PoA), located at 1871 Anchorage Port Road, Anchorage, AK 99501. The funding would be used for the PAMP's electrical substation project to design and construct electric infrastructure and emergency electricity generation equipment to power Don Young Port of Alaska's cargo terminals.

The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because the PAMP electric substation project will modernize the PoAs cargo terminal power systems and move them to a seismically hardened, tsunami-protected site that is out of the way of dock and transit yard operations. The project will improve PoA power system reliability and resilience and improve cargo handling safety and economics.
